CAMP HOURS & LATE FEE

Kids Connection summer camp operates Monday- Friday 7:00am -6:00pm Jul. 3rd – Aug. 31st. Please note we are closed on all Statutory Holidays. A late fee of \$1/ minute applies after 6pm.

Please note the camp will be CLOSED on Jul.1st, Aug. 7th & *Aug 31st, 2018 (Daily rates apply to the last week of camp.)

OUR STAFF

Our camp staffs are qualified Early Childhood Educators, Child Youth Workers and Ontario Certified Teachers who are First-Aid and CPR trained individuals, working with children 6-12yrs old on a regular basis.

VOLUNTEERS

We encourage and welcome community college student' teachers and parent volunteers. All volunteers must be 18yrs or older and provide a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Screening done within the past 6 months (*please request a copy of our volunteer policy for more information*).

WITHDRAWAL & REFUND POLICY

You may withdraw from camp at any time, however 2 weeks written notice is required. No refund will be given for sick or missed days.

MEDICATION

Health and safety are priorities for KCCE. Please ensure your child's information is accurate by completing the medical information portion on your Registration Form. Campers who require prescribed medication at camp must indicate this on the registration form. Medication forms are available prior to and during camp from the Camp Supervisor. Medication must be prescribed by a physician and must be stored in original containers only. They will be kept in a locked box in the camp office. If your child develops a communicable disease during camp (e.g. Pink Eye), we ask that you inform staff immediately. This will allow us to inform other participants so they can take the necessary precautions.

LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS

KCCE will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Electronic hand held games are not permitted at camp (iPads, Nintendo DS etc.). Please leave your valuable items at home.

HUMIDEX WARNINGS/TRIPS

Camp will continue during humidex warnings; however, campers will be moved indoors to a more moderate climate and programs will be adjusted for indoor conditions. Trips maybe cancelled/rescheduled or changed due to heat alerts. ***Please note our facilities are not air conditioned however each class is equipped with fans.*** We encourage campers to bring their water bottles daily.

FEES & TAX RECIEPT

Your **non-refundable** registration fee is due upon submission of camp forms. Camp fees for July is due June 29th & August fees are due July 30th. A tax receipt will be issued at the end of the year in December. We accept cash, chq or money order. **Cheques should be payable to KCCE.**

WHAT TO BRING

Please send your child with a water bottle, sun hat, sunscreen, bathing suit/swim trunks, towel and extra clothing. Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to arrival. Please ensure you label all items belonging to your child.

PICK UP/DROP OFF

Children should be picked up and dropped off in their classroom. To ensure maximum safety, sign in and sign out of each camper is required daily. It's the parent/guardians responsibility to ensure campers are signed in/out. I.D. will be required if camper is been picked up by anyone other than parents.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Every person has the right to be treated with dignity and respect in a safe environment. Each person has a responsibility to show respect for other people and their property and accept the consequences for own behaviour.

Electives

Art Express – Campers will learn the different types of creative arts such as drama, dance and creative storytelling based on in-school curriculum.

Basketball – Our campers will get the opportunity to learn the fundamental skills, drills and movements of basketball with a heavy emphasis on teamwork and leadership.

Chamalea Science- Our campers will participate in various science workshops such as “Grossology, Minions & Mystery of Ancient Egypt” lead by the instructors from Chamalea Science.

Culture Shock Dance - Through Hip Hop dance, Culture Shock provides a positive outlet in which our campers develop self-confidence and build life skills. The programs also aim to create opportunities and experiences for all children.

Electro Tag – Campers will get to experience a non-gun laser tag system. Outfitted with super high-tech Electro-Gloves, Electro-Vests and superhero capes, your kids will have a blast! Electro-Tag includes individual *Free-For-All challenges* as well as intense team games like *Electro-Capture-The-Flag!*

Freeze DNA – Campers will get the opportunity to express their creative, artistic abilities which can help build up their self-esteem!

Karate – Campers will learn self-defense, anti-bullying and life skills that will help build up their confidence, self-esteem and leadership skills.

Latin Drumming-Drumming is an excellent way for children to learn self-awareness, listening skills, coordination of breath and movement, cooperation and patience.

Soccer – Campers will get the opportunity to learn the fundamental skills, drills and movements of soccer with a heavy emphasis on teamwork and leadership.
